



## **ICDPPC Census 2017: Notes by ICDPPC Secretariat**

### **Information about publication and release of information**

The information gathered through the census will be analysed and used by the ICDPPC Secretariat to produce reports that will be presented at relevant events (such as the ICDPPC annual meeting and the planned ICDPPC-OECD-APPA roundtable on privacy metrics) and published on the ICDPPC website.

To enable further analysis and production of additional reports the information gathered may be shared by the ICDPPC Secretariat with:

- The ICDPPC Data Protection Metrics Working Group;
- The OECD Secretariat;
- Other networks of privacy and data protection authorities (e.g. to facilitate region-specific or network specific studies);
- Approved researchers.

The information gathered may be retained by the ICDPPC Secretariat, and passed onto subsequent Secretariats, to enable comparisons with any later census.
