The CNDP virtual library is a website accessible throughout the Commission online platform that gather and deliver to the Moroccan people and the African community a large amount of knowledge in the personal data field.
The CNDP aim to enrich this library gradually until it becomes the reference in the data protection field across Africa.

That is why, the Moroccan Data Protection Authority has decided to launch a virtual library aiming to be the main African reference in data protection field.
With more than 100 books, as a start, the main goal behind the launching of the CNDP library is to deliver a higher amount of knowledge in different languages to the Moroccan and African searchers in the data protection field wherever they are and whenever they need it.
In order to facilitate access to the open access books, the CNDP library had adopted a very user-friendly interface that is available on its website, this interface offers a multiple search

criteria (authors, titles, editions, publication dates, full-text search) and an overview of the collections throughout a very useful classification that helps users to easily locate books within its subject (privacy laws across the world, privacy and kids, Surveillance and monitoring, Advertising and marketing, Technology and privacy....).

- The CNDP library is the first library initiated in Africa.
