4. **Description of the initiative**

The tool "Privacy Notices Generator for the Public Sector" (GAP for the public sector) is an application compatible with the most used internet browsers that allows data controllers in the public sector to generate privacy notices in accordance with the corresponding law, based on an automated questionnaire. This, in order to comply with the information principle.

- b. Please provide a full description of the initiative (no more than 350 words):

The central axis of the GAP for the public sector tool is based on the design of a dynamic questionnaire implemented in html format, which is composed of sections which include questions that consider the mandatory information elements that the privacy notice must have in accordance with the General Law on Protection of Personal Data Held by Obligated Parties (LGPDPPO) and its General Guidelines.

The dynamic questionnaire consists of eleven sections: (i) statistical information; (ii) modality of the privacy notice; (iii) name of the data controller; (iv) address of the data controller; (v) purposes of the processing; (vi) personal data collected; (vii) transfers of personal data; (viii) legal basis; (ix) mechanisms, means and procedure for the exercise of the rights to access, rectification, cancellation and opposition; (x) changes to the privacy notice; and (xi) site where the privacy notice can be consulted.

This development is accessible from a web page. The tool has a registration system, which

allows users to recover their password and delete their account. It also allows a period of inactivity before closing session, it validates the data entered by the user and indicates the incidents that are found during the filling of the information. Likewise, it includes help icons which can be consulted to: a) obtain supporting information to answer any given question; b) access to the LGPDPPSO for its prompt consultation, and c) access to the tool's user manual.

On the other hand, the tool includes an administration manager on the number and types of privacy notices that can be made, allowing users to have no limits on the amount of privacy notices that they need to generate. In addition, each privacy notice is stored individually with the information that has been included in the responses of the dynamic questionnaire, so the system orders the finalized or unfinished privacy notices from the most recent to the oldest on a board.

Users can perform any of the following activities from their session:

- Generate privacy notices in full or short versions;
- Download the privacy notices, which have been generated in Word or PDF formats;
- Modify privacy notices; and
- Remove previous privacy notices.

- c. Please explain why you think the initiative deserves to be recognised by an award (no more than 200 words)

The GAP for the public sector was developed from the analysis of the regulatory framework applicable to the public sector. Therefore, with the systematization of the information and the design of the dynamic questionnaire, those data controllers that use this tool can obtain information regarding what should be contained in a privacy notice. Furthermore, the tool allows the users to create any privacy notices that they require by imputing the relevant information into the tool's questionnaire. Also, they can generate all the privacy notices that they require, depending on the personal data they process, without being specialists on this matter.

Through the questionnaire, the tool identifies and validates the user's responses, showing the questions and / or sections required for each type of privacy notice, based on the previous responses. It also has interactive elements that include help information without having to leave the questionnaire. These elements allow any user to elaborate, through the tool, in an approximate time of one or two hours, a privacy notice in editable format.

We consider that the GAP for the public sector is an ideal tool to facilitate public sector data controllers' compliance with the information principle.
